LIMITED WARRANTY

Gas Furnaces: CG-7 Series & CG Series

ComfortStar® USA warrants that the gas furnace conforms to the manufacturer's specifications and will be free from defects in materials and workmanship as listed and described below.

- The unit must be matched and registered (except Quebec, CA Florida, USA and California, USA) within **sixty (60) days** of installation in a residential/multifamily installation, the warranty covers all parts including the Heat Exchange for **ten (10) years** from date of installation to the owner of the property where the system was installed.
- The matched and unregistered or if unmatched default warranty covers all parts for a period of five (5) years and the Heat Exchange for ten (10) years from date of installation to the owner of the property where the system was installed.

The replacement of a part or unit under this warranty does not extend the warranty period. ComfortStar® USA warrants a replacement part or unit only for the period remaining in the applicable warranty that commenced on the registered installation date.

Units must be installed within 18 months of the manufacturing date to qualify for warranty coverage.

Any unit installed after this period will not be covered under the ComfortStar warranty.

The Warranty may be registered at www.ComfortStarUSA.com.

This warranty period begins on the date of the original installation registered or verified by installation service receipt or invoice from contractor to customer. If the date cannot be verified, the warranty period begins four (4) months from the date of manufacture.

For units installed in commercial or non-residential applications, the limited warranty covers parts for five (5) years and the Heat Exchanger for ten (10) years from the date of original installation. If the installation date cannot be verified, the warranty period begins four (4) months from the date of manufacture. Commercial installations are not eligible for extended residential registration benefits.

All Implied Warranties, including but not limited to warranty of merchantability and fitness for particular purpose are limited to the duration of this warranty. Some States and provinces do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply.

IN NO EVENT WILL ComfortStar® USA BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EXTRA UTILITY EXPENSES OR DAMAGES TO PROPERTY.
